- **Bilge Painting and Sunroof Motor Servicing:** These were executed to maintain cleanliness, prevent corrosion, and ensure the reliability of the sunroof operation.

Maintenance and Protection

To further ensure the longevity and durability of the yacht:

- Anchor and Chain Galvanization: This process provided added durability and resistance to corrosion.
- **Sikaflex Replacement:** This was essential in maintaining the integrity of the yacht's watertight seals.
